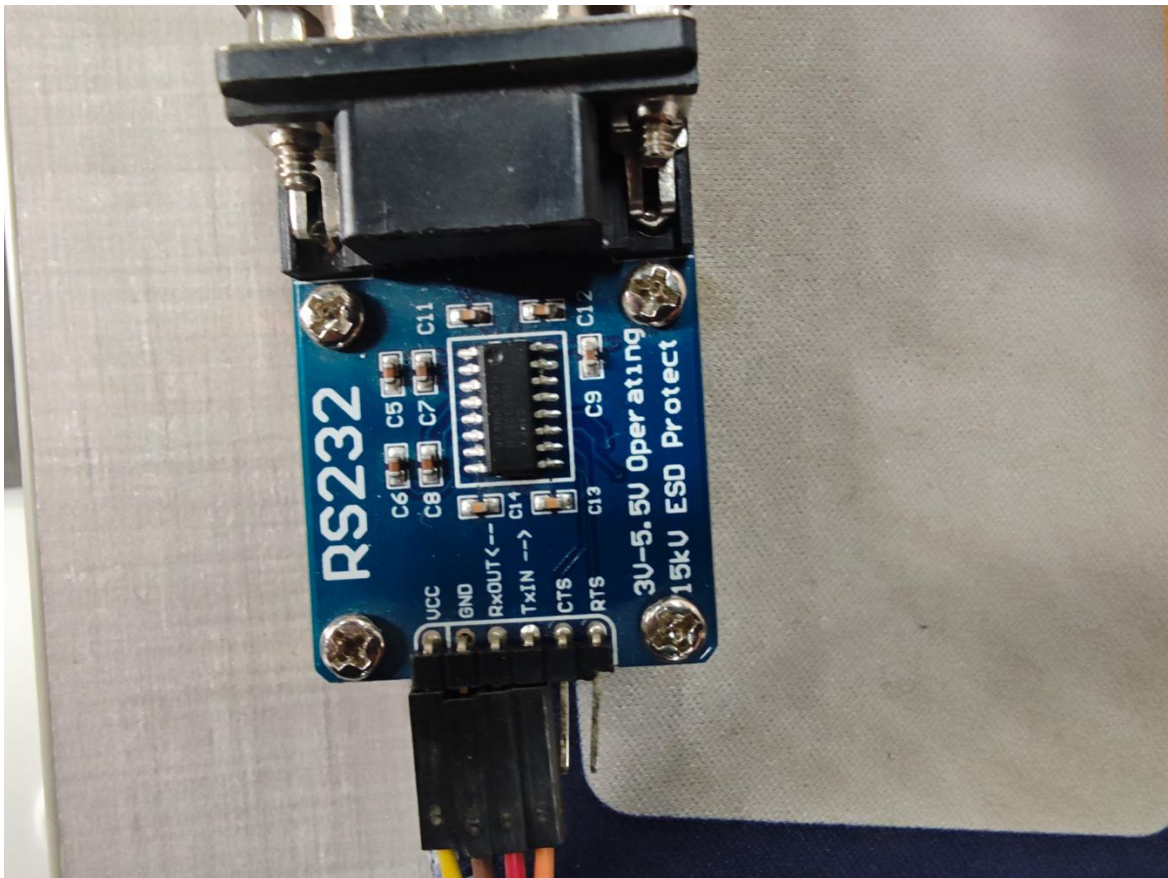




How to install OpenWiFi image

1 Install via uboot

1. Set up a TFTP server.
2. Log in to the AP via the serial port.
 - a) Some APs come with an exposed serial port by default—either USB or RJ45. Others don't expose one; in that case, you'll need to open the AP's enclosure and use DuPont jumper wires to connect to the serial header on the main board. (115200, 8N1)



Connection between TTL and AP:

TTL	AP
-----	----



Tx	Rx

3. Download the firmware to the AP via TFTP and write into the AP's nand. For Qualcomm-based APs, the procedure is as follows:

```
setenv ipaddr 192.168.11.200
```

```
setenv serverip 192.168.11.30
```

```
ping ${serverip}
```

```
tftpb 0x44000000 openwrt-ipq50xx-xxxx-squashfs-nand-factory.bin
```

```
imxtract 0x44000000 ubi
```

```
flash rootfs
```

```
reset
```

2 Upgrade via you old AP system

1. Copy the new AP firmware (usually a .tar file) to the AP using the scp command.
2. `sysupgrade -F xxx.tar`

3 Other scenarios

For MTK-based APs, the serial-port upgrade procedure is as follows:

1. Put the latest sys upgrade image to TFTP server and make it short name like fw.bin
2. Select Upgrade firmware option

- 1. Startup system (Default)
- 2. Upgrade firmware
- 3. Upgrade bootloader
- 4. Upgrade bootloader (advanced mode)
- 5. Load image
- 0. U-Boot console

```
Press UP/DOWN to move, ENTER to select
```

3. Select upgrade firmware option via TFTP and then enter info of device and TFTP server

```

4. Then wait for it to download and flash image:
